1105 **Peri-operative Neurocognitive Disorder**

Abstract: Cognitive change affecting patients after anesthesia and surgery has been recognized for more than 100 years. Research into cognitive change after anesthesia and surgery accelerated in the 1980's when multiple studies utilized detailed neurophysiological testing for assessment of cognitive change after cardiac surgery. In Western countries, approximately 37% of all surgical procedures are performed on patients over 65 years of age. Many patients are affected by peri-operative neurocognitive disorder (PND), either in the short term, which includes delirium and delayed neurocognitive recovery (dNCR), or in the longer term, which includes post-operative neurocognitive disorder. Despite the prevailing debate on the pathophysiology of PND, there are now at least four prevailing hypotheses as to its causation. Based on the available literature, the 5th International Perioperative Neurotoxicity Workshop came up with best practice recommendations that address four key issues: pre-procedure consent, pre-operative cognitive assessment, intra-operative management, and post-operative follow-up.
